Program:

The Five County Building Official's Association (FBOA) Academic Scholarship was established to promote student excellence and achievement. The scholarship will be awarded to an immediate family relation of a FBOA member who shows promise of continued academic achievement, not only in the construction industry, but in all fields. A scholarship shall be awarded annually to the most accomplished and most promising applicant. The FBOA Board of Directors shall determine the amount and number of scholarships awarded each year. The recipient shall be chosen by a scholarship committee.

Eligibility Requirements:

Applicants must:

1. Be an immediate family relation of a current FBOA member (spouse, son, daughter, grandchild, or Legal Ward).
2. Be a high school senior or college student.
3. Provide a letter of recommendation from a professor, teacher, or guidance counselor.
4. Verify that he/she has been admitted for full or part-time enrollment at an accredited college or university.
5. Complete the scholarship application in its entirety.

Terms of Scholarship:

1. The 2009 FBOA Academic Scholarship is in the amount of \$500.00.
2. If the recipient is unable to proceed with plans, the runner up will be awarded the scholarship.
3. Applicants will be judged on the basis of academics, honors/recognition, personal recommendations of teachers, professors or counselors, and career goals.
4. Check will be made payable to the student and institution upon verification of registration.
5. **Application Deadline: Application must be postmarked by October 28, 2009 and mailed to: Charles E Huber

6. The scholarship recipient will be notified by telephone and letter by November 25, 2009.

Note: The FBOA Scholarship Award may be reapplied for annually by a recipient of a previous award.
